At the regular April term of the Circuit Court begun and held in the Court house in the City of Barron on the 12th day of April, 1904. Present and presiding, the Hon. A. J. Vinje, Circuit Judge, this 13th day of April, 1904.

The issue joined in this action coming on for trial in said term and having been tried before the court, Clarence C. Roe & Arthur E. Roe appearing for the plaintiff and James Robbins for the defendant, after hearing the allegations and proofs of the parties, the arguments of counsel and being advised in the premises, I, the Judge before whom the same was tried, do decide and find, that the allegations of the complaint are proven and true and that the plaintiff, the mother is the fit and proper person to have the care and custody of the children and supervision of their education, except of Robert, aged 7 years and that the father is the fit and proper person to have the care and custody of Robert.

And I find and decide as conclusions of law, that the plaintiff is entitled to divorce from the bonds of matrimony as prayed in the complaint, and that the plaintiff be awarded the care and custody of the minor children Dora J., Jennie, & Clarence and that the defendant be awarded the care and custody of the minor child Robert.

Therefore, on motion of Clarence C. Roe & Arthur E. Roe Attorneys for the plaintiff, it is adjudged and determined by the Court; that the bonds of matrimony heretofore subsisting between the plaintiff Jennie M. Knutson and the defendant, Louis Martin Knutson be and the same are hereby wholly dissolved. That the custody of Dora J. Knutson, Jennie Knutson, and Clarence R. Knutson, be and is hereby awarded to the plaintiff. That the care and custody of Robert J. Knutson be and is hereby awarded to the defendant. A. J. Vinje, Circuit Judge.
